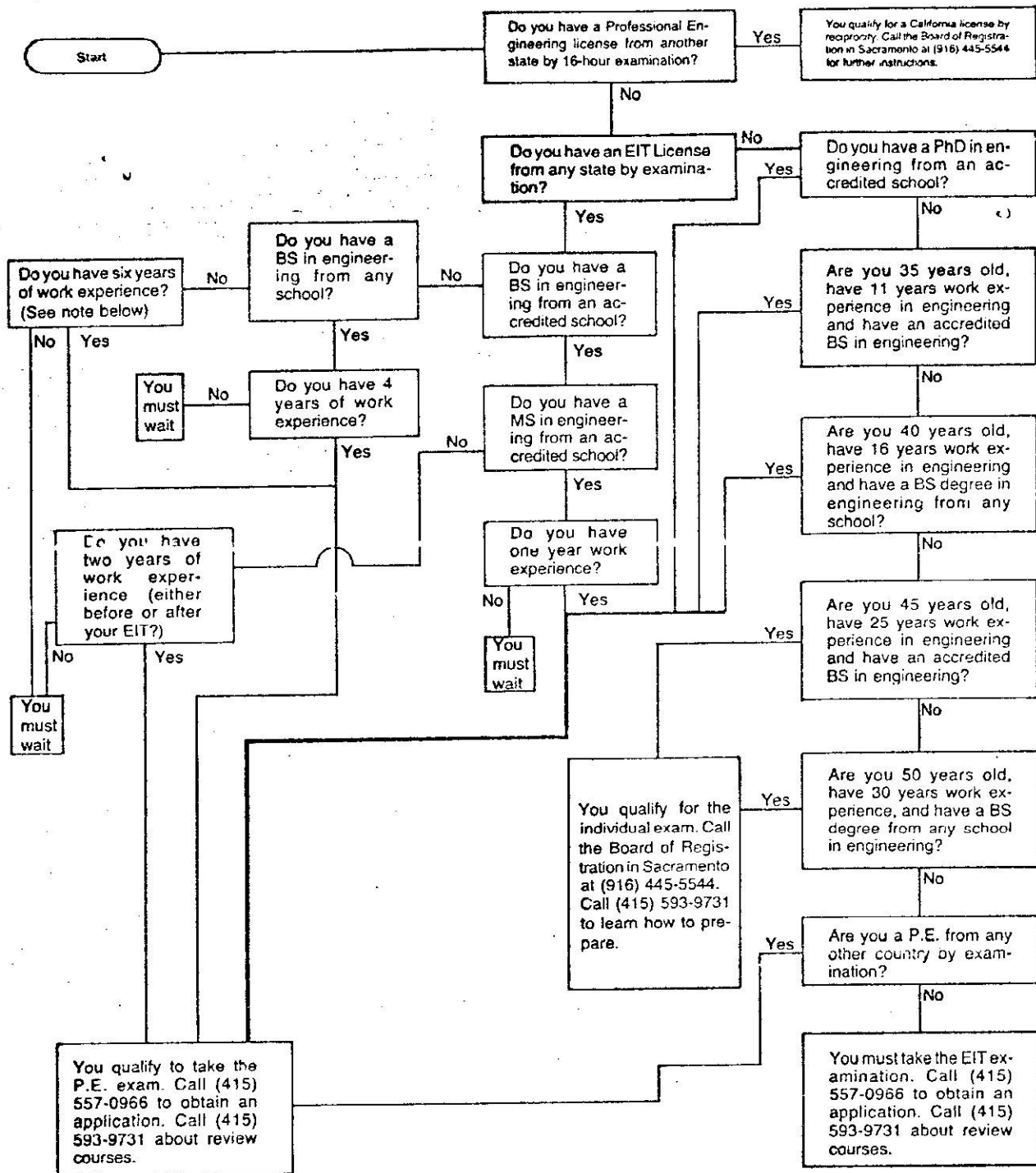

NOTE: 1/2-year of qualifying experience credit is granted for each year of undergraduate education in engineering even though no degree was awarded. All education and degrees must be in Engineering. Business, chemistry, mathematics, and physics degrees are not acceptable. No degrees from universities outside of the U.S. are accredited.
